- Investigated and pursued numerous options to replace hall and manage parking
- Diocesan proposal late Fall 2024
- Modified Diocesan proposal January 2025
- Recent Conversations in the Spirit* process helped clarify what is most important to the Parish

What are the Important Building Attributes?

■ The Worship Space

- Spiritual, Welcoming, Sacred, Reverent, Beautiful
- Accessible

■ The Hall, Meeting Rooms and Offices

- Functional Offices, Storage, Meeting Spaces, Gathering Places
- Commercial Kitchen
- Accessible

Four Building Options for Consideration

- Do nothing
- Fundraise and <u>build a new hall and parking lot</u>
- Development of the hall and parking lot areas
 - New hall in ground floor of a six-storey housing development
- Development of <u>the entire block</u>
 - New church, hall and offices in ground floor of a six-storey housing development
